Psychological American Association (APA) is used for many academic writings. It is important reference to each article accurately to give recognition the original to author(s) as well as enabling readers to locate a specific text. Referencing is vitally and morally important, in any form of writing style as it is unethical and illegal to use another author's words.

Basic rules to APA Style

- Cover page should include: title of the paper, your name, and school affiliation
- Times New Roman font, size 12
- Include running head
- Add page number
- Double Space
- Indent new paragraphs
- "References" should be centered, bold and on a separate page
- References should be alphabetical
- Hanging indentation for references


