

Galen University and Ministry of Blue Economy sign MOU for curriculum on Blue Economy

On September 6, 2021, Galen University and the Ministry of Blue Economy and Civil Aviation signed a memorandum of understanding for the development, research and delivery of a curriculum on blue economy.

The curriculum will be the first of its kind in Belize.

Chairman of the Board of Trustees, Dr. Rene Villanueva along with the Provost, Dr. Eve Aird and the Dean attended the ceremony.

Minister of Blue Economy and Civil Aviation, Andre Perez said that the ministry is working on finalizing a 5-year national multisector blue economy plan. He further invited Galen University to participate in this strategic plan.

Dr. Aird confirmed Galen's commitment to supporting blue economic development in Belize. This collaboration between Galen University and the Ministry of Blue Economy is an exciting start that will create new opportunities for students to learn more about the 'blue resources' here in Belize.
