ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A willingness to work hard, expand academic skills, strengthen character, respect others, keep abreast of social issues,
 analyze social problems, work in interdisciplinary groups and apply knowledge and skills acquired to solve social problems
- A commitment to high standards of personal ethics in all human interaction at Galen University

Only applicants who meet all the following requirements are usually considered for admission. Candidates who fall just short of these requirements may appeal to the Admissions Board via admissions@galen.edu.bz for consideration.

- Statement of Purpose (2.5 3 pages)
 - Rationale: Identify significant factors that influenced your decision to pursue a Master of Social Work (MSW) degree and how you intend to use it in the future. (1-2 paragraphs)
 - Social work values and ethics: Describe your understanding of the social work profession and its core values. Compare your own values with the professional social work values, any potential value-based or ethical conflicts you might experience, and how you plan to address or reconcile these conflicts (whether it be in the classroom, in the field, in future practice, or in any other areas). (1 page)
 - Personal and professional attributes and liabilities: Describe any cultural, economic, or social challenges and/or
 opportunities that have provided you with a unique perspective on social work issues. What insights did you gain
 from these experiences about how to maintain professional judgment and performance during times of distress? (1
 page)
 - Employment and volunteer history: Discuss the relationship between your educational, employment, and/or volunteer experiences and what qualities equip you for the social work profession. Describe your experiences and feelings about working with populations different from your own. (1-2 paragraphs)
 - OPTIONAL: Please address any special academic or other considerations that you would like admissions to consider in the review of your application. (1-2 paragraphs)
 - Sign your statement of purpose to confirm that it is your work and it is a true reflection of your thoughts and writing skills. Any evidenced conclusion that your submission is not your own work will be grounds for denial of admission into Galen.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS CONTINUED

- A Cumulative GPA of at least 3.00 on a 0.00 4.00 Grade Point Scale from your feeder institution
- CV (including education history, relevant and length of work experience, volunteer experience, publications in scientific journals, and proficiency in a second language or a combination of these).
- Official transcript(s) of the applicant's bachelor's degree program grades. The transcript(s) must be sent directly to Galen University from the applicant's university that issued the bachelor's degree. If not in English, it must be translated by a certified translator
- A scanned Justice of the Peace-certified or notarized copy of the applicant's bachelor's degree certificate.
- A scanned copy of a valid Social Security card
- Recommendations. Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a professor or supervisor who is sufficiently knowledgeable of the applicant to comment on the prospect of the candidate's competency to succeed in Master level studies.
